Applikabbli għas-setturi pubbliċi u privati, ir-regolamenti jintroduċu obbligi relatati mat-trasparenza tal-pagi, l-aċċess għall-informazzjoni, ir-rappurtar, u l-infurzar. Il-prinċipali għandhom jimplimentaw strutturi ta' pagi bbażati fuq kriterji newtrali għall-ġeneru u jipprovdi lill-ħaddiema u lill-applikanti għall-impjieg b'aċċess għal informazzjoni relatata mal-pagi. Prinċipali li jimpjegaw mitt (100) haddiem jew aktar huma soġġetti għal obbligi addizzjonali, inkluża t-thejji ta' Rapportu dwar id-Differenza fil-Pagi u, fejn meħtieġ, iwettqu valutazzjonijiet kongunti tal-pagi. Ir-regolamenti ulterjorment jistabbilixxu mekkaniżmi ta' infurzar u pjeni f'kazijiet ta' nuqqas ta' konformità.

2.2 L-Importanza tar-regolamenti

Dawn ir-regolamenti jsahħu l-infurzar ta' paga ugwali billi jintroduċu miżurita' trasparenza u akkontabbiltà immirati li jidentifikaw u jindirizzaw diskrepanzi mhux ġustifikati fil-pagi bejn is-sessi. Huma jippromwovu Prattiki ta' paga ġusti, jikkontribwixxu għal aktar ugwaljanza fil-post tax-xogħol u jiżguraw ukoll il-konformità ta' Malta mal-obbligi tagħha skont il-liġi tal-Unjoni Ewropea.

4. Kummentarju

Regolament 1

Dan ir-regolament jistabbilixxi t-titolu u l-għan tar-regolamenti u jikkonferma li dawn jittrasponu d-Direttiva (UE) 2023/970. Japplikaw għal prinċipali kemm fis-settur pubbliku kif ukoll f'dak privat u għall-haddiema kollha f'relazzjoni ta' impjeg, u f'ċerti każijiet għall-applikanti għall-impjeg.

Regolament 3

Il-prinċipali għandhom jiżguraw li l-istrutturi tal-pagi jkunu bbażati fuq kriterji oġġettivi u newtrali fir-rigward tas-sessi u li paga ugwali tiġi pprovduta għal xogħol ugwali jew xogħol ta' valur ugwali. Id-differenzi fil-paga huma permessi biss fejn ikunu ġġustifikati minn fatturi oġġettivi u newtrali, u l-kriterji għandhom ikunu aċċessibbli għall-haddiema.

Regolament 4

L-applikanti għall-impjeg huma intitolati li jirċievu informazzjoni dwar il-paga inizjali jew il-medda tal-paga għal pożizzjoni. Il-prinċipali huma pprojbti milli jitolbu informazzjoni dwar l-istorja tal-pagi tal-applikanti u għandhom jiżguraw li l-proċessi ta' reklutaġġ u r-reklami tax-xogħol ikunu newtrali fir-rigward tas-sessi u mhux diskriminatorji.

Regolament 5: Prinċipali huma meħtieġa jzommu kriterji oġġettivi, newtrali għall-ġeneru u aċċessibbli li jirregolaw il-livelli tal-pagi u l-progressjoni fil-pagi. Prinċipali li jhaddmu numru żgħir ta' haddiema jistgħu jkunu eżentati minn ċerti rekwiżiti formali, filwaqt li jibqgħu obbligati jiddokumentaw internament il-kriterji relatati mal-pagi.

Regolament 6: Il-haddiema għandhom id-dritt jitolbu informazzjoni dwar il-paga tagħhom u l-livelli medji tal-pagi għal xogħol komparabbli, u l-prinċipali għandhom iwieġbu fuq żmien stabbilit. Ir-regolament jistabbilixxi wkoll mekkaniżmi ta' eskalazzjoni, obligi ta' informazzjoni annwali u rekwiżiti dwar iż-żamma tad-data għal prinċipali.

Regolamenti 7–8: Dawn ir-regolamenti jiżguraw aċċess għall-informazzjoni għall-haddiema kollha, inkluż persuni b'diżabilità, u jistabbilixxu kif għandu jiġi evalwat xogħol ugwali jew xogħol ta' valur ugwali. Ir-regolamenti jipprovdu wkoll regoli dwar il-paragun tal-pagi, inkluż fis-settur pubbliku, u jippermettu l-użu ta' evidenza alternattiva fejn ma jeżistix komparatur dirett.

Regolament 9: Prinċipali li jimpjegaw mitt (100) impjegat jew aktar għandhom iħejju Rapporti dwar id-Differenza fil-Pagi bejn il-ġeneri u jissottomettuhom lill-Korp ta' Monitoraġġ. Ir-regolament jirrikjedi wkoll konsultazzjoni mar-rappreżentanti tal-impjegati u azzjoni korrettiva fejn jiġu identifikati differenzi fil-pagi mhux ġustifikati.

Regolament 10: Fejn tiġi identifikata differenza fil-pagi mhux ġustifikata ta' mill-inqas hamsa fil-mija (5%), prinċipali huma meħtieġa jwettqu evalwazzjoni kongunta tal-pagi b'konsultazzjoni mar-rappreżentanti tal-impjegati. Ir-regolament jipprovdi wkoll għal miżuri korrettivi, proċeduri ta' konċiljazzjoni u referenza lit-Tribunal Industrijali f'każ ta' tilwim.

Regolamenti 11–12: Dawn ir-regolamenti jinnominaw lid-Dipartiment għar-Relazzjonijiet Industrijali u tal-Impjeg bhala l-Korp ta' Monitoraġġ responsabbli għas-sorveljanza tal-implimentazzjoni l-konformità. Fir-rigward ta' uffiċjali pubbliċi fis-servizz pubbliku, dawn il-funzjonijiet jitwettqu mid-Divizjoni dwar Nies u Standards, b'koordinazzjoni bejn il-Korp ta' Monitoraġġ u l-Korp għall-Ugwaljanza sabiex jiġi żgurat infurzar effettiv.

Regolamenti 13–22: Il-haddiema huma intitolati jfittxu rimedju quddiem it-Tribunal Industrijali għal ksur tal-obbligi relatati mal-paga ugwali, inkluż kumpens u rkupru ta' pagi mitlufa. Ir-regolamenti jistabbilixxu wkoll salvagwardji kontra l-vittimizazzjoni, regoli dwar l-oneru tal-prova u l-perjodi ta' preskrizzjoni, kif ukoll pieni u miżuri ta' infurzar f'każ ta' nuqqas ta' konformità.

Regolament 23: Dawn id-dispożizzjonijiet jirregolaw it-trattament ta' ftehimiet kollettivi eżistenti, partikolarment fir-rigward ta' haddiema ssekondati jew forniti fis-settur pubbliku. Huma jipprovdu li ċerti differenzi fil-pagi li jirriżultaw minn dawn il-ftehimiet ma jistgħux jiġu kkontestati taħt dawn ir-regolamenti sakemm il-ftehimiet jibqgħu fis-seħħ.

5. Sezzjonijiet konklużivi

Ir-regolamenti għandhom jidhlu fis-seħh mal-pubblikazzjoni tagħhom fil-Gazzetta tal-Gvern.

Explanatory Notes¹

1. Introduction

Title of Regulations	Equal Pay (Transparency and Reporting) Regulations, 2026 (hereinafter referred to as the “regulations”)
Activities to be regulated	Equal pay for equal work or work of equal value, including pay transparency, reporting obligations, and enforcement mechanisms.
Responsible entity	Department for Industrial and Employment Relations (DIER)

2. Summary and background

These regulations transpose Directive (EU) 2023/970 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 10 May 2023 to strengthen the application of the principle of equal pay for equal work or work of equal value between men and women through pay transparency and enforcement mechanisms into Maltese law and strengthen the principle of equal pay for equal work or work of equal value between men and women. Applicable to both the public and private sectors, the Regulations introduce obligations on pay transparency, access to information, reporting, and enforcement. Employers must implement gender-neutral pay structures and provide workers and job applicants with access to pay-related information. Employers with one hundred (100) or more workers are subject to additional responsibilities, including the preparation of Pay Gap Reports and, where necessary, carry out joint pay assessments. The regulations further establish enforcement mechanisms and penalties in cases of non-compliance.

2.2 Importance of regulations

These regulations strengthen equal pay enforcement through greater transparency and accountability measures aimed at identifying and addressing unjustified gender pay gaps. They promote fair pay practices, enhance equality in the workplace, and ensure Malta’s compliance with European Union obligations.

2.3 Public Consultation

Consultations were held with the Employment Relations Board (ERB), composed of government, employers, and trade union representatives. Discussions focused on implementation timelines, reporting obligations, enforcement measures, and administrative burdens. Stakeholder feedback contributed to provisions aimed at ensuring proportionality, clarity, and effective implementation in line with Directive (EU) 2023/970.

3. Overview of the structure of the instrument

These regulations are structured into several Parts, which collectively establish the legal framework for equal pay and pay transparency:

- Part I – Equal Pay for Equal Work or Work of Equal Value
- Part II – Pay Transparency
- Part III – Reporting
- Part IV – Monitoring and coordination
- Part V – Miscellaneous provisions

4. Commentary

Regulation 1

This regulation establishes the title and scope of the regulations and confirms the transposition of Directive (EU) 2023/970. It applies to employers in both the public and private sectors, workers in an employment relationship, and, in certain cases, applicants for employment.

Regulation 3

Employers must ensure that pay structures are based on objective, gender-neutral criteria and that equal pay is provided for equal work or work of equal value. Pay differences are permitted only where objectively justified and neutral, and the relevant criteria must be accessible to workers.

Regulation 4

Applicants for employment are entitled to receive information on the initial pay or pay range for a position. Employers are prohibited from requesting applicants' pay history and must ensure that recruitment processes and job advertisements are gender-neutral and non-discriminatory.

Regulation 5: Employers are required to maintain objective, gender-neutral, and accessible criteria governing pay levels and pay progression. Employers employing a small number of employees may be exempt from certain formal requirements, while still being required to document pay criteria internally.

Regulation 6: Workers have the right to request information on their pay and average pay levels for comparable work, and employers shall respond within specified timeframes. The regulation also establishes escalation mechanisms, annual information obligations, and data retention requirements for employers.

Regulations 7–8: These regulations ensure access to information for all workers, including persons with disabilities, and establish how equal work or work of equal value is to be assessed. The regulations also provide rules on pay comparison, including in the public sector, and permits the use of alternative evidence where no direct comparator exists.

Regulation 9: Employers with one hundred (100) or more employees shall prepare Pay Gap Reports on gender pay differences and submit them to the Monitoring Body. The regulation also requires consultation with employees' representatives and corrective action where unjustified pay gaps are identified.

Regulation 10: Where an unjustified pay gap of at least five percent (5%) is identified, employers are required to carry out a joint pay assessment in consultation with employees' representatives. The regulation also provides for corrective measures, conciliation procedures, and referral to the Industrial Tribunal in case of disputes.

Regulations 11–12: These regulations designate the Department for Industrial and Employment Relations as the Monitoring Body responsible for overseeing implementation and compliance. In relation to public officers within the public service, these functions are carried out by the People & Standards Division, with coordination between the Monitoring Body and the Equality Body to support effective enforcement.

Regulations 13–22: Workers are entitled to seek redress before the Industrial Tribunal for breaches of equal pay obligations, including compensation and recovery of lost pay. The regulations also establish safeguards against victimisation, rules on the burden of proof and limitation periods, as well as penalties and enforcement measures for non-compliance.

Regulation 23: These provisions regulate the treatment of existing collective agreements, particularly in relation to seconded or supplied workers in the public sector. They provide that certain pay differences arising from such agreements cannot be challenged under these regulations while the agreements remain in force.

5. Concluding sections

The regulations shall come into force upon their publication in the Government Gazette.
